EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 20-32

CORONAVIRUS – RESCISSION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 20-02

WHEREAS, the majority of COVID-19 cases in Nebraska at the onset of the pandemic were related to travel outside the State of Nebraska;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 20-02 was issued on March 16, 2020, in order to suspend all out-of-state travel by state teammates working in the executive branch of state government including both Cabinet and independent state agencies; and

WHEREAS, restrictions and Directed Health Measures now in place no longer necessitate restrictions on out-of-state travel by state teammates.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Pete Ricketts, Governor of the State of Nebraska, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Nebraska, hereby order that Executive Order No. 20-02, dated March 16, 2020, be rescinded effective at 11:59 P.M. on July 7, 2020.
