EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 21-06

**CORONAVIRUS – Rescission of Executive Order Nos. 20-06, 20-09, 20-13,
20-14, 20-19, 20-21, 20-22**

WHEREAS, Nebraskans have greatly sacrificed over the past 14 months in order to reduce the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Nebraska families and businesses have weathered great hardship in order to protect Nebraska's hospital capacity; and

WHEREAS, over 1.6 million vaccines have been administered to date and over 50% of Nebraskans eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine are fully vaccinated; and

WHEREAS, it is important that we as a state continue to transition back to a more normal way of life as we experienced before the COVID-19 pandemic, including reconnecting as fellow Nebraskans and returning more people to the workplace.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Pete Ricketts, Governor of the State of Nebraska, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Nebraska, find these conditions merit the rescission of COVID-19 related executive orders.

Pursuant to this declaration, Executive Order Nos. 20-06, 20-09, 20-13, 20-14, 20-19, 20-21, 20-22 shall be rescinded on June 1, 2021.
