EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 23-08

Open Fire Ban – Rescission of Executive Order No. 23-07

WHEREAS, wildfires threatened communities across Nebraska, exacerbated by dry weather and moderate to extreme drought conditions; and

WHEREAS, fire risk to people and property may have created problems greater in scope than local governments could resolve; and


WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 23-06 was issued on April 13, 2023 (expiring on April 16, 2023) and Executive Order No. 23-07 was issued on April 17, 2023, to suspend the authority of local fire chiefs to waive the statewide burn ban.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Pillen, Governor of the State of Nebraska, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Nebraska, hereby order that Executive Order No. 23-07 be rescinded effective at 11:59 p.m. on April 20, 2023.
