EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 23-14
Rescission of Executive Order

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska seeks to partner proactively with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration to enhance commercial vehicle safety on Nebraska's roadways;

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska recognizes the circumstances causing a state of emergency for the delivery of fuel products extend beyond the borders of the state, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration has authority to issue regional emergency declarations to provide broad relief for multiple states, and

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska has requested regional relief for haulers of fuel products and reasonably expects the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration to act on that request.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Joe Kelly, Acting Governor of the State of Nebraska, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Nebraska, do hereby rescind the Executive Order signed by Governor Jim Pillen on June 6, 2023, titled "Emergency Relief Due to Fuel Supply Shortages - Extended,"

in anticipation of action from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration as they continue to review the need for relief and appropriate remedies provided by Federal Regulation.
