EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26-04
Dynamic Pricing

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared on January 23, 2026, regarding power demand due to sub-zero temperatures; and

WHEREAS, the State of Emergency impacts the use of dynamic pricing for transportation network companies under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-327; and


WHEREAS, the use of dynamic pricing may be necessary in the operation of business for transportation network companies.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Pillen, Governor of the State of Nebraska, under and pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Nebraska, waive the specific requirements on transportation network companies imposed by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-327(2)(d)(iv) for the remainder of the State of Emergency declared in Executive Order 26-01.
