

EXECUTIVE ORDER

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Nebraska it is ordered as follows:

1. The title of the Governor's Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice established by virtue of an Executive Order dated the 18th day of September 1967 is hereby changed to the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice.

2. The purposes, functions and membership of the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice shall be the same in all respects as the Governor's Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice.

3. Duration of Commission. This Commission shall cease to exist 90 days following the adjournment of the 80th Session of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature.
