EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon an employer to take appropriate actions to protect its employees from dangerous conditions in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, because unrestrained automobile crashes are the most common cause of both on-the-job injury and death;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert Kerrey, Governor of the State of Nebraska, do hereby order as follows:

Every agency of State government is directed to develop and implement a policy which requires every person to use an approved seatbelt while driving or riding in any motor vehicle while on State business.

Each policy should include disciplinary actions to be taken according to the State Personnel System against employees who do not comply with the policy.
