## EXECUTIVE ORDER

NO. 9

E. Benjamin Nelson  
Governor

WHEREAS, Drug Interdiction and Counter Drug Activities are a vital function of State Government; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Title 32, United States Code as amended and the Nebraska National Guard Drug Enforcement Assistance Program with Annexes, A through Y provide guidance for the execution of the FY92 Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities Support Plan and provide funding from the U.S. Department and Defense; and

WHEREAS, The State of Nebraska has committed to assuring a Drug-Free environment;


WHEREAS, the Governor, as Commander in Chief of the Nebraska National Guard, may employ the militia to aid in the relief of the state; and

WHEREAS, I find that the Nebraska National Guard would be of assistance to the interdiction activities and in relief of the state and its citizens;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, E. Benjamin Nelson, Governor of the State of Nebraska, having reviewed the FY92 Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities Support Plan as the Commander in Chief of the Nebraska National Guard, hereby order and direct:

That Major General Stanley M. Heng, the Adjutant General, Nebraska National Guard, shall implement the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Support Plan in relief of the State, granting unto him all powers necessary to effect said relief.
