EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 19-07

EMERGENCY RELIEF DUE TO WEATHER EVENTS – EXECUTIVE ORDERS EXTENDED

**WHEREAS**, the catastrophic weather event culminating in a State of Emergency declared March 12, 2019, has resulted in widespread destruction of property; and

**WHEREAS**, these conditions threaten essential public health and safety services and endanger public property if response and recovery operations are disrupted.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Pete Ricketts, Governor of the State of Nebraska, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Nebraska, find these conditions constitute an on-going State of Emergency within Nebraska, as of April 10, 2019 through May 15, 2019.

Pursuant to this declaration, I hereby order the following:

1. The extension of Executive Orders 19-02, 19-03, 19-04, 19-05, and 19-06 through May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska to be affixed on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 2019.
