EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 24-05
Transportation Network Companies

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared on June 22, 2024, to address ongoing flooding and storm damage concerns to private and public property and infrastructure in the state of Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the State of Emergency impacts the operation of business for transportation network companies under Neb. Rev. State § 75-327; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Pillen, Governor of the State of Nebraska, under and pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Nebraska, waive the specific requirements on transportation network companies imposed by Neb. Rev. State § 75-327(2)(d)(iv) for the remainder of the current State of Emergency.
