EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 87-5

WHEREAS, nearly 300 people die and 20,000 are injured annually in Nebraska motor vehicle crashes;

WHEREAS, one collision occurs every 14 minutes in Nebraska;

WHEREAS, motor vehicle accidents are the number one on-the-job killer;

WHEREAS, safety belt use reduces fatalities by 50 to 60 percent;

WHEREAS, safety belt use reduces the number of injuries received by 50 percent;

WHEREAS, employee safety belt use results in significant savings of both human and financial resources; and

WHEREAS, an Executive Order issued January 31, 1985, required every State agency to develop and implement a policy which requires seatbelt use while on State business;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay A. Orr, Governor of the State of Nebraska, hereby order as follows:

Every agency of State government shall review its seatbelt policy to ensure that the policy is effective, that the policy is being implemented, and that every employee is aware of the policy.
