BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED in the Governor by the Constitution and the statutes of the State of Nebraska, including Laws 1988, LB 1233, I, Kay A. Orr, Governor of the State of Nebraska, hereby order the following:

That a state volume cap allocation under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, be granted to the City of Omaha in the amount of \$5,615,000 for the Riverfront Redevelopment Project No. 1, Tax Allocation Bonds, Series 1988A.
